Mission

Our mission is to strengthen families and empower individuals — children and adults alike — to reach their fullest potential.

What We Do Founded in 1899 with a focus on child protection and adoption, Children's Aid and Family Services has placed more than 11,000 children with families. While helping children and families is still a core part of our mission, the agency has evolved and expanded to meet ever-changing social needs. In addition to adoption, our programs include:

- Community residences, specialized services and day programming for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities.
- Therapeutic Foster Care services provided by foster parents who receive specialized training to provide care in their homes to children and teens who have suffered from neglect, abuse and trauma.
- Support services for young adults who "age out" of foster care at 18 years old.

- Free nutritional formula, diapers and other baby essentials for low-income families.
- Free housing, safety-net services and mentoring for young mothers and their children in order to promote economic and educational mobility.
- Community and school-based substance misuse prevention and education programs and peer recovery support services.

Zoe's Place

Baby Basics

Thanks to volunteers from M&T Bank for helping us prepare packages for our Baby Basics program, which provides free nutritional formula and diapers to low-income families in Bergen and Essex Counties.



STRIVE Day Program

Children's Aid and Family Services began 2019 with six community residences supporting 27 individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities and ended the year with 16 community residences supporting 85 individuals. Our STRIVE Day Program grew threefold, serving 60 individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities by the end of the year.



Strengthening Families Program

More than 90 families (over 100 parents and 130 children and teenagers) participated in the Strengthening Families Program. The multi-session program was implemented 12 times in nine communities and was offered in both Spanish and English.

MESSAGE FROM THE Board Chair

he year 2019 was certainly a milestone in Children's Aid and Family Services' history. Not only was it our 120th year of serving some of the most vulnerable children, adults and families in our community, it was also a year of opportunities and growth. We are deeply grateful to all of you – our supporters, volunteers and dedicated staff. Because of everyone's efforts, we helped more people than ever: over 26,000 vulnerable children, adults and families.

Last year, we were asked by the state of New Jersey to take over the operation of eight community residences for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities in Passaic County. It was a big challenge, but with the Children's Aid team pulling together, we were able to integrate the homes into the agency in eight weeks! What's more, we grew our behavioral supports and medical services for the residents to ensure they receive the specialized services needed to help them lead lives of possibilities.

On another positive note, our Baby Basics program expanded its reach to Essex County, more than doubling the number of families it serves. In 2019, the program distributed more than 215,000 diapers and helped 340 low-income families in urgent need to keep their babies healthy and happy.

Additionally, The Center for Alcohol and Drug Resources expanded its recovery support in the community. In partnership with the Bergen County Sheriff's Office, our Recovery Specialists began working with individuals with a substance use disorder after their arrest and subsequent incarceration at the Bergen County Jail to provide support to assist with their recovery and transition back into the community. Many of these people become members of The Center's STAR (Support

Team for Addiction Recovery) expansion program and receive case management and recovery support services for one year. The STAR expansion increased the program's capacity by 50%, now serving 60 people each year.

We remain deeply committed to helping vulnerable children and are focusing our efforts on recruiting therapeutic foster families for the children who have experienced severe trauma as well as loving adoptive families for older children. Through our recruitment efforts, seven older children found permanent adoptive families. We also provide vital services to help young adults as they transition out of foster care into independent living to help them achieve educational and career goals and build strong futures.

After more than 14 years of dedicated service and leadership, Joanne Mandry decided to retire from the agency in June. She has had a remarkable record of success during her career at the agency. On behalf of the Board of Trustees, I thank Joanne for her leadership and distinguished service to our organization and to the community.

I'm delighted to introduce Benita Miller, who joined Children's Aid and Family Services as President and CEO in July 2020. Benita has spent her more than 20-year career working on behalf of children and families, and I invite you to learn more about her vision for the agency in an interview with her that is featured in this year's annual report.

For 120 years, Children's Aid and Family Services has built brighter futures for thousands of vulnerable children and families. This life-affirming work would not be possible without you. Thank you for your invaluable support and commitment.

CEO of Children's Aid and Family Services

Benita R. Miller, Esq. was appointed as President and CEO of Children's Aid and Family Services in July 2020.

Benita has spent her more than 20-year career working on behalf of vulnerable children and families. She most recently served as Executive Director of the Brooklyn Kindergarten Society, an early education program that serves more than 400 children through seven centers in central Brooklyn. Formerly, she was an attorney in the juvenile rights practice of the Legal Aid Society of Brooklyn; founded and led the Brooklyn Young Mothers Collective, a program to help pregnant and parenting adolescents; served as Deputy Commissioner, Division of Family Permanency Services in New York City; and was Executive Director of the New York City Children's Cabinet, in the office of the Mayor. Benita holds a J.D. from Syracuse University College of Law.

Q. Why do you want to lead Children's Aid and Family Services?

A. I am delighted to lead CAFS because of the rich history and commitment to mission. More importantly, I am thrilled to advance the agency's work to support vulnerable community members.

A. My vision for CAFS is big! I want to strengthen existing programs, explore opportunities to innovate and support all staff in their role as change makers and service leaders in their own right. I want to leverage my many years of experience as a direct service provider and advocate to foster creativity and enthusiasm about our work.


Q. What are your top three priorities for **Children's Aid and Family Services?**




