What We Do

Founded in 1899, Children's Aid and Family Services has a rich history of protecting vulnerable children. While our roots are in adoption, our mission has evolved and expanded to address a broader range of social needs. Today, we provide a wide array of programs, including:

Disability Support Services

Community residences and day programming for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

Children and Family Services

Treatment Foster Care for children and teenagers, support services for teenagers who have aged out of care, and adoption and kinship services.

Baby Basics

Free diapers, nutritional formula, and other baby essentials for low-income families.

The Center for Alcohol and Drug Resources

Community and school-based substance misuse prevention, education programs, and peer recovery support services.

Children's Aid and Protective Society of the Oranges was established. First official meeting of the board of directors was held February 9, 1899, in Orange, NJ.

Family Counseling Service of Ridgewood and Vicinity, Inc. was founded.

Woodlea group home for adolescent girls was established in Ridgewood with the support of the Junior League of Bergen County.

Our 200 Robin Road facility in Paramus opened, bringing together administrative and program staff, along with the Turrell Child Care & Early Learning Center.

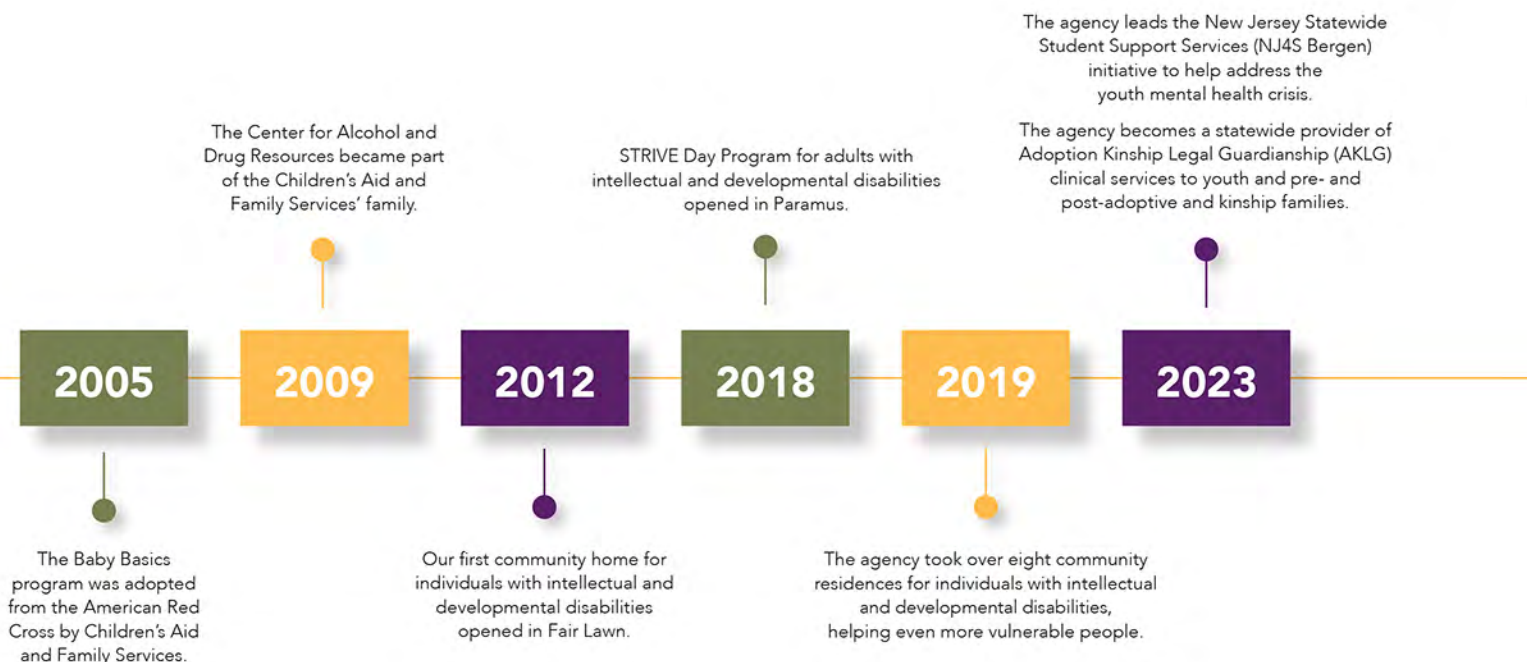

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Children's Aid and Family Services has persevered through pandemics, wars, and recessions, yet continues to evolve and serve the needs of the community. Thanks to your support, we are 125 years strong and continue to grow.

Throughout this milestone year, we reflected on

the people and programs that brought us to this moment. In 2024, we expanded our reach and impact in meaningful ways. We opened our 19th group home for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities, continuing our commitment to compassionate, person-centered care. Participants in our STRIVE Day Program engaged in enriching activities designed to build life and social skills in a supportive environment.

We extended our prevention efforts by partnering with five Bergen County colleges to tackle substance misuse among students. With decades of successful prevention work in K-12 schools, our programs are now helping students across all grade levels.

We also launched two new programs, NJ4S (New Jersey Statewide Student Support Services), which is meeting youth mental health needs throughout the Bergen County school district, and Adoption Kinship Legal Guardianship Clinical Services, which supported 62 families in its first year. Our leadership in adoption and reunion remains central to our mission, with nine adoptions and reunions in 2024.

A key strength throughout our history has been our ability to adapt and grow. To guide our future, we spent 18 months working with our Board of Trustees to develop a comprehensive five-year strategic plan. As part of the process, we updated our Mission and Vision to better reflect who we are today and where we are going. This new roadmap will lead us through 2029, ensuring we continue to evolve and meet the needs of children, adults, and families.

Your partnership is the reason we've reached this incredible milestone, and it's the reason we are optimistic about the future. Thank you for your support, trust, and unwavering belief in our mission.

19 Group Homes Providing Compassionate Care

For over 50 years, Woodlea Group Home in Ridgewood, NJ has served vulnerable individuals, including children in foster care. In 2024, it was fully renovated to serve individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities, continuing its legacy of addressing significant needs in the community.

62 Families Served 4 Adoptions Finalized

Children's Aid and Family Services was chosen by NJ's Department of Children and Families to provide pre- and post-adoption counseling. The Adoption and Kinship Legal Guardianship Clinical Services (AKLG) program strengthens family bonds and helps ensure permanency.



450,000 Diapers Donated

Our Baby Basics program made a significant difference last year, reaching more families than ever. We distributed over 450,000 diapers, a nearly 12% increase from 2023, and helped 700 families, a 15% increase.



Extending Prevention to All Grade Levels

A new grant from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) is enabling The Center for Alcohol and Drug Resources to expand its prevention services across Bergen County schools and colleges. The Center was one of only 44 organizations awarded a national SAMHSA Partnership for Success Grant (out of 350 applicants). The grant:

- Targets students ages 17–25
- Develops tailored strategies for substance misuse prevention and mental health wellness
- Serves all five higher education institutions in Bergen County: Bergen Community College, Eastwick College, Fairleigh Dickinson University, Felician University, Ramapo College

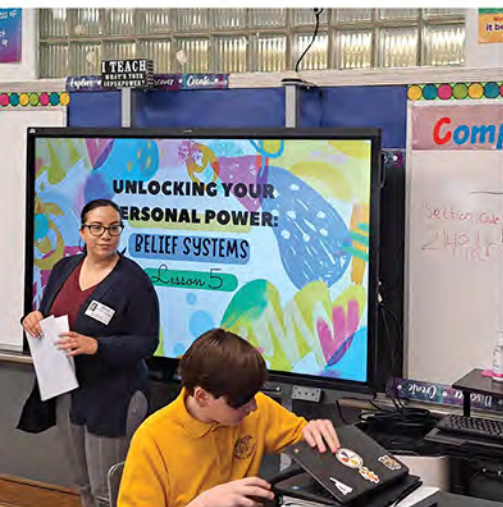
125th Anniversary

Children's Aid celebrated our special anniversary with our dedicated and generous supporters at the 125 Years of Impact 5K and A Night Among the Stars events.

Aging Out Youth

We provide one-on-one mentoring and financial assistance to young adults who have aged out of foster care and have no family support. We are proud to report:

- 100% of our participants have a bank account
- 94% are enrolled in school or working
- 62% are pursuing higher education
- 94% are in safe and independent housing



Youth Mental Health Program: NJ4S

Launched in 2023, NJ4S (New Jersey Statewide Student Support Services) addresses the mental health needs of students in schools and communities across Bergen County. In 2024:

- 5,148 community members received mental health and prevention programming
- 2,602 Bergen County students received evidence-based instruction from trained prevention staff
- 50 school districts and 70 schools requested services for students, families, and educators



Recovery Support Saving Lives



- 119 community outreach tables to connect individuals to addiction treatment, recovery support services, Narcan and fentanyl test strips
- 1,096 Narcan kits distributed in the community
- 1,309 calls to the 24/7 hotline from community organizations and individuals seeking addiction support for themselves or a loved one
- 202 law enforcement officers trained on recovery support services, harm reduction, and engagement

Young people aging out of foster care who are in our Mobility Mentoring program enjoyed a holiday party with our staff and supporters.

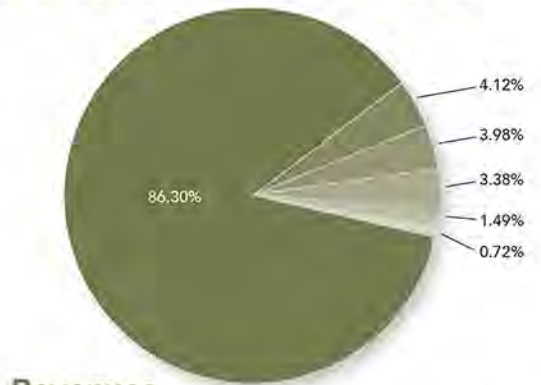

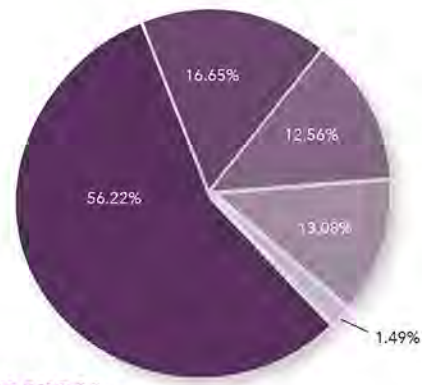

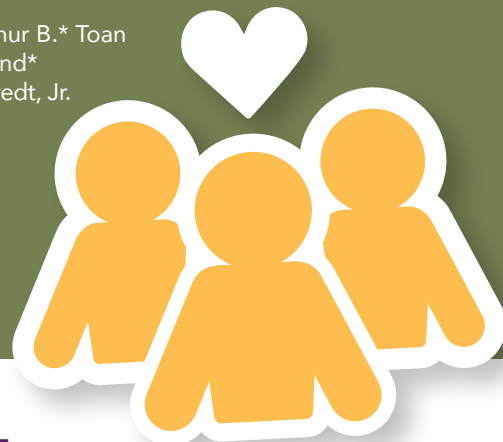
